### **Letter of Assessment**

From 05-Feb-2024 to 11-Mar-2024, pursuant to our agreement with Atlassian Pty Ltd (Atlassian), elttam conducted an adversary simulation assessment.

The assessment was divided into two tasks. The first task included all external facing assets owned by Atlassian with the objective of evaluating the resilience of the Atlassian's external infrastructure against unauthorised access, data breaches, and other malicious activities through simulation real-world attack scenarios from an outsider's perspective. The second task included the internal network facing assets owned by Atlassian starting from the perspective of compromised Atlassian user credentials on both Atlassian and non-Atlassian hardware. This activity prioritised the identification of sensitive information and accessible applications to an adversary who had compromised Atlassian employee credentials, acquired relevant application session tokens, or compromised Atlassian devices. A focussed review of a new sensitive internal application was also performed.

The engagement concluded with a close-down meeting where findings were discussed with stakeholders. A final report, detailing technical issues and offering remediation advice, was then provided to Atlassian Pty Ltd.
