LETTER OF ASSESSMENT

Beyond Binary was engaged by Atlassian to conduct a comprehensive security assessment of the Bitbucket Server and Bitbucket DC application and codebase. The assessment was targeted to version 8.3.1 of the software and was performed by two security consultants over three weeks in September 2022.

Beyond Binary testers conducted code-assisted dynamic web application penetration testing on the Bitbucket Server and DC products. Beyond Binary maintained regular communication with the Atlassian security team and developers throughout the engagement to report identified issues and better understand security impact.

A combination of manual and automated code review techniques was utilised along with dynamically analysing and tampering with web traffic in an interception proxy, and reviewing application source with a debugger.

Beyond Binary helps companies take responsibility for securing their systems and networks in a time when technology moves faster than even the most vigilant businesses can keep pace with. Companies are ultimately responsible for protecting their own data and the personal information of customers, and mismanagement of this critical area can have a crippling impact on business.

Our team have been involved in the delivery of a wide range of security services, including penetration testing, red team engagements and attack simulations.
